Give the gospel visible form through concrete trust and obedience.

Good Questions

- What does life under the reign of Jesus look like here?
- What obedience does the kingdom now require?
- What concrete form of trust would oppose the false belief?
- How would your true identity become visible in this situation?
- What would it look like to tell the truth rather than manage the impression?
- Is Jesus inviting you to move toward someone rather than withdraw?
- Is there a Scripture you need to pray when the old fear rises?
- What loving action would show the reign of Christ in this situation?
- What would it look like to seek peace, mercy, or reconciliation?
- What is one faithful next step you can actually take?

Rules of Thumb

- Kingdom is concrete obedience, not another layer of insight.
- Choose a response that contradicts the false belief and expresses true identity.
- Look for trust made visible in speech, relationships, repair, and action.
- Keep the response specific enough to practice.
- The reign of Jesus moves outward in truth and love.
- Self-understanding is useful, but it is not the end of the process.
